SUBJECT: -Extension of General Affiliation up to Senior Secondary Level .

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. In this connection, I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Extension of General Affiliation as per details given below:-

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal-Vatika shall be restricted to 6 (Two sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively) and total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 10 for class I to X. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school is not bounded with Six feet boundary in the play area that part of school land covered with wire/fence. School shall be bounded with 6 Ft concrete boundary wall from all sides. Thus, school is directed to complete the boundary wall from that side also within 03 months and submit the compliance.
3	Only 2 CwSN Toilets are constructed by the school, CsWN Toilet for Boys is on Ground Floor and for Girls on 1st Floor. Fixtures and one side support bar is not installed in the CwSN Toilet. School is directed to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
4	The Library has enough space but very few seating arrangement made by the school in the reading area developed by the school. School is directed to increase the seating capacity to accommodate 50 students at a time in the light of SoP issued by the Board within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	School has increased the number of computers but the plastic stools are provided in the Computer Lab for seating which is not appropriate. School shall provide the chair with the back support for seating in the lab for students within 03 months and submit the compliance.
6	The composite lab set up is still not proper, with chemistry section in a separate room, work stations with inbuilt utilities not available for bio section and plastic stools for seating, the school shall upgrade the same as per sop of the board within 3months and submit compliance .

The school shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers with CoE, Thiruvananthapuram, within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
8. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
